The program will take place at the LRTX outdoor workspace and sculpture garden in West Oak Cliff three weekend days in October and November.

Art Chicas Unidas is an annual program of **LRTX** that seeks to combine high school girls with a wide range of Dallas' female art mentors. Our focus is on building teamwork and creative thinking through hands-on experience. We encourage student involvement and seek to build an artist-mentor relationship where students explore their artistic expression in a gender-neutral environment.
